Information PIOs need to know about UAS (drones).

Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS, or drones) are being used more often, both by the media to gather information, and by PIOs to create their own content. But the increased use of UAS is also resulting in air traffic and safety concerns. This workshop will teach you some of the ups and downs of UAS use.

At this CAPIO workshop you will learn about:

- UAS licensing, operation and regulations.
- UAS use at wildfires. How PIOs can assist the media in getting footage without affecting operations, and preventing hobbyists from interfering.
- Taking your own UAS footage to create media interest.
- How the media is using UAS, and media expectations for UAS use at incidents/news scenes.
- Restrictions on media use of UAS at crime scenes; use of UAS for Search and Rescue and other safety activities.
