Marianna Moles is passionate about changing perceptions about social issues through storytelling. She joined County of Santa Clara Public Health Department as the Public Communications Specialist, after interviewing homeless people and writing their stories for the Office of Supportive Housing. At Public Health, she provides communications and media relations for nearly 40 different programs that promote healthy living to over two million county residents. Prior to working for the County, she was the sole communications person at Downtown Streets Team, a rapidly growing nonprofit whose mission is to end homelessness. In this role, she changed perceptions about homeless people through organizing benefit concerts, public speaking at schools, creative brand awareness, and video production. In 2014, she produced a video entitled "We'll Lift You Up," to spotlight the realities of homelessness, which received CreaTV San Jose's 2015 "Non-Profit Short" award. Marianna also writes self-deprecating, witty and humorous reflections about everyday human behavior on her blog, The Meandering Mole, and volunteers as a Visual Storyteller for the American Red Cross.
